



## 2010 OPTIONAL EXTENSION—PRE-PROGRAM TRAVEL

### VICTORIA FALLS, ZIMBABWE

*“Discovered” by western explorers more than 100 years ago, Victoria Falls is one of the most spectacular natural wonders of the world. Known by the locals as Mosi-oa-Tunya, or Smoke That Thunders, Victoria Falls is the place where the Zambezi River falls 100 meters (300 feet) at the rate of 17.6 million cubic feet per minute.*

#### Day One

##### Arrival in Johannesburg

Arrive in Johannesburg and transfer to your nearby hotel.

#### Day Two

##### Journey to Zimbabwe

Fly this morning to Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe. You'll be met by your local guides before checking into your hotel.

#### Day Three

##### Experience the Culture

Zimbabwe is famous for intricate beadwork and woodcarvings. A visit to the Traditional African Craft Village, where such items are produced, is an opportunity to see artists at work and admire their creations.

The surrounding rainforest abounds with exotic birds, butterflies, and foliage. Discover the diversity as you walk along winding pathways. You'll soon understand why Victoria Falls is called “Smoke That Thunders.”

After lunch and a rest, enjoy a cruise on the calm waters of the Upper Zambezi River. Take in the sights and sounds of the river ecosystem as you enjoy refreshments. The cruise is a relaxing way to observe a variety of wildlife and witness a spectacular African sunset.

In the evening, embark on a fascinating cultural experience at the Boma—place of eating. Partake in an abundance of Zimbabwean dishes, traditional dancing, music, and folklore.

#### Day Four

##### Return to Johannesburg

You will be met on arrival and transferred to the group hotel for your stay in the Johannesburg area. Enjoy the rest of the evening on your own before your professional program begins.
