Student Ambassador Programs

People to People Student Ambassadors travel to every continent on the globe, primarily during the months of June, July, and August, with additional programs taking place during winter break. Comprising up to forty students per group, delegations visit exciting locations on all seven continents, from Europe to Asia, Africa to Antarctica.

Leadership Programs

People to People’s Leadership Programs are designed to help develop and grow tomorrow’s leaders. Students from over 100 countries have come together on People to People Leadership programs.

World Leadership Forum – A week of interactive leadership training from members of the U.S. Congress and other government officials in Washington, D.C. each spring and fall.

Leadership Summit – Students explore college and career paths in fields like medicine and healthcare, business, and international diplomacy on prestigious college campuses around the country.

Learning to Lead and For Young Women summits also bring together young leaders from all nations in grades 6-12. Students learn college admissions success strategies and prepare for a leadership roles in their communities.

Citizen Ambassador Programs

People to People Citizen Ambassador Programs provide foreign educational travel experiences for adults, most of them specific to a career field or specialty such as law, education, or medicine. Citizen Ambassadors frequently form lasting collaborations with counterparts in Asia, Africa, Eastern Europe, and the Middle East.

Sports Ambassador Programs

People to People Sports Ambassador meet, compete against, and make friends with athletes from around the world in an Olympic-style events or while participating in leadership and team-building activities with a sports focus. Athletes in grades 5-12 can compete internationally in baseball, basketball, bowling, football, softball, soccer, swimming, tennis, volleyball, and wrestling.
